As mentioned last month there are a number of activities underway and or are being planned to improve our Lakewood links. A few of the completed items include...

Limbing up trees on hole 10, as well as left of number 18 green and right side of number 6 fairway. More trees will be limbed up this winter. A new filter box was installed in Lake Tullahoma to minimize silt getting into the intake irrigation pump pipeline. Special thanks to Jon Gault, Jon Bell, and David Burns for their assistance with installation. Also, thank you to Russ Barrett for lending us a boom lift to help with installation. Fertilizer has been spread across the golf course fairways, tees and roughs. We are pending the contractor's availability to repair the concrete cart path issues and we are planning to install and level the irrigation heads this winter.

Since last year's planting, our new greens have been on the firm side but of late ball marks are being noticed so please don't forget to look for and mend any that are made.

The greens are looking great and we want to keep them that way!
