GREENS & GROUNDS - TREVOR VESTAL & GREG GATES

We have finished the full process of aerification, verticutting and heavy top dress with sand and now beginning to see great growth on our greens. This is our first full application that involved double verticutting and core aerification. During the process of topdressing with sand the process takes its toll on the mowing reels. Our reels are in the process of being picked up and sharpened and at that point once we can use them, we will see the true benefits of the process. When we consider this process compared to our old greens, we will have great playing surfaces in 30 days (once a year) compared to 6 weeks each in the Spring and the Fall with the old greens.

Our project on Hole 3 is coming to a close. We plan to lay new sod on Thursday, 8/7. Thanks to Steve Cope, we were able to have TUA remove the dead trees on Hole 3 as well. We will replant in the fall with smaller plants.

We have been prepping Hole 12 back tee to prepare to plant and grow new sod.

Once both of these projects are completed, Trevor will begin work on Hole 9. We are wrapping the existing bunker around the back of the green which will be a huge improvement on this hole gaining benefits in many areas.

The Greens and Grounds committee continues to work together to focus on the everyday priorities, and changes throughout the year to improve our golf course. Thanks again to those that contribute their time to bring value and on-going support to Trevor and his staff to give us the best playing conditions possible.

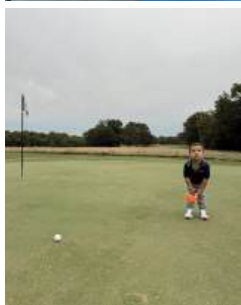

2024 MEN'S CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP Aug 9-10

Format: 36-hole stroke play individual competition. Players must declare their division when signing up in the proshop. There will be 5 divisions:

- Championship Division Black Tees
- Men's Division White Tees
- Senior Championship (55-64) White Tees
- Legends Division (65+) Gold Tees
- Super Legends (75+) Red Tees

Saturday Tee Times: 9AM-12PM

Sunday Tee Times: 10AM-12PM

Cost: \$50

Skins Game: \$10 Per Day

Rules: USGA rules will govern all play:

- Doubt to procedure - If a competitor is doubtful of his rights or the correct procedure during the play of a hole he may, without penalty, complete the hole with two balls. The competitor must announce to his fellow competitors that he intends to play 2 balls and which ball he wishes to count if the rules permit.
- The ditches on #2, #12, and #13 are marked ground under repair in the fairway only.
- Ties for first place will be a sudden death playoff. All others will be broken using the USGA recommended procedure.
- Ground Under Repair - Marked with white paint.
- Electronic measuring devices are allowed for distances only.

Tee Times: On day one you may request pairing with someone in your division. Pairings and tee times will be made by the Head Pro on day 2 of the event. No requests will be considered.

*Winners will be determined by gross score first, and players left over will be considered for the net category.
