Section 7. Golf Course Rules, 2. Motorized Golf Carts., B. Operating Rules -

1. Drivers of powered golf carts must be 15 years of age or older. Drivers under the age of 15 may operate a powered golf cart when accompanied by an adult, such as a parent or legal guardian.

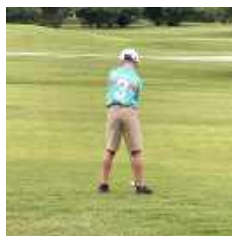
