IMPORTANT LAKEWOOD RULE

LGCC Rules, Section 7. Golf Course Rules, 2. Motorized Golf Carts
B. Operating Rules - 1. Drivers of powered golf carts must be 15 years of age or older. Drivers under the age of 15 may operate a powered golf cart when accompanied by an adult, such as a parent or legal guardian.

You will be prompted to login to Club Prophet (which is different from website login). If you don't know or remember your login, simply type your email in, click next, and then Password Recovery.

If you need to cancel your tee time, click My Account in the top right corner of the tee time page, then Reservations, and then Cancel Booking.

LAKWOOD - POOL OPERATIONS

GENERAL RULES:

1. Every person entering the pool area is required to sign the register.
2. Authority for the safe and proper operation of the pool and enforcement of the rules is vested in the on-duty lifeguard, pool committee chairperson and or Board of Directors.
3. Any person interfering with the enjoyment or jeopardizing the safety of others may have their swimming privileges suspended.
4. A snack bar adjoining the pool will be available to all swimmers and hours of operation will be posted in the newsletter. Each person using the snack bar must help to keep the area clean.
5. No glass containers of any kind are permitted in the pool area.
6. Persons with a severe head cold, open cuts, sores, athletes' foot, infection or any contagious disease will not be permitted in the pool.
7. Bathers are permitted only in the restrooms beside pool entrance and should not enter any other portion of the Clubhouse without wearing shoes and shirts or cover-ups.
8. Lifeguards on duty will take periodic breaks. During these said breaks, everyone will exit the pool and will return when the guard sounds a whistle.
9. All swimmers must wear suitable swimming apparel as determined by the management and or the lifeguards. No one may swim in clothes they have worn while playing golf, tennis or other activities.
10. No one is allowed on or in the lifeguard stand except for lifeguards at any time.

WHO MAY USE THE POOL:

1. Children of members who are not competent swimmers are permitted to use the main pool only when they are accompanied by one or more of their parents, adult members of their family or caretaker, who must be in the water with the child at all times and be responsible for the child's safety.
2. Non-swimming children of members are permitted to use the wading pool if supervised in the wading pool area by a parent, adult members of their family or caretaker, who are responsible for the child's safety at all times.
3. When no lifeguards are on duty, only those 14 years of age and older are allowed in the pool area unless accompanied by an adult.
4. If children come to the pool without their parent, the accompanying responsible adult member must have a written consent from the parent.

SWIM PARTIES

1. Application for swim parties must have manager approval prior to the event.
2. Rental for swimming parties shall be obtained from the club business office.
